



**SPRING SEASON ZONE 6 FISHERY**  
**Platform and Hook and Line Fisheries WILL CLOSE**  
**May 18, 2023 at 6 PM**

*Pursuant to Chapter 2, Section 2.08, of the Fish & Wildlife Code of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, the Fish & Wildlife Commission (FWC) has the authority to establish emergency regulations for CTUIR ceremonial, subsistence and commercial fisheries. Pursuant to that authority, the Fish & Wildlife Commission approved the following fishing regulations for CTUIR tribal fishers, which close the Zone 6 fishery. These regulations shall become effective immediately, unless otherwise stated. These regulations are in addition to all previously promulgated fishing regulations.*

**SPRING PLATFORM AND HOOK & LINE FISHERIES:**

**AREA:** All of Zone 6  
**DATES:** Closure at 6 PM Thursday, May 18, 2023.  
**GEAR:** No gear allowed during the closure.

Note: The summer fisheries period begins on Saturday June 16 and effective management will be officially announced before that time. Subsistence platform fisheries will likely re-open during the summer management period
