SPRING SEASON ZONE 6 FISHERY Platform and Hook and Line Fisheries WILL CLOSE May 18, 2023 at 6 PM

Pursuant to Chapter 2, Section 2.08, of the Fish & Wildlife Code of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, the Fish & Wildlife Commission (FWC) has the authority to establish emergency regulations for CTUIR ceremonial, subsistence and commercial fisheries. Pursuant to that authority, the Fish & Wildlife Commission approved the following fishing regulations for CTUIR tribal fishers, which close the Zone 6 fishery. These regulations shall become effective immediately, unless otherwise stated. These regulations are in addition to all previously promulgated fishing regulations.

SPRING PLATFORM AND HOOK & LINE FISHERIES:

- AREA: All of Zone 6
- DATES: Closure at 6 PM Thursday, May 18, 2023.
- **GEAR:** No gear allowed during the closure.

Note: The summer fisheries period begins on Saturday June 16 and effective management will be officially announced before that time. Subsistence platform fisheries will likely re-open during the summer management period
