

NOTICE of CTUIR 2026
Moose Limited Entry Hunt for Blue Mountains

The CTUIR Fish and Wildlife Commission, in recognition of the Treaty reserved right to harvest moose, will use a hunt tag draw system for tribal harvest in the Blue Mountains of Oregon and Washington. The draw system will be conducted to optimize hunt opportunities to benefit the greatest number of tribal hunters possible. Applicants must be at least 18 year of age to apply. Permit applications and complete application procedures will be available from Fish and Wildlife Program Staff or on the CTUIR Web site.

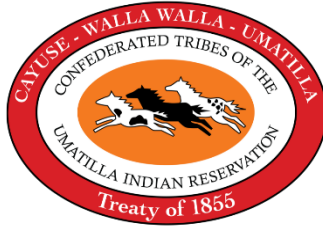
Hunt drawing will be conducted in public at the Hunters Forum July 28th at 4:30pm NGC room 101. This method and the public setting will assure that no bias is introduced to the draw program and provide clear accountability to the public.

The CTUIR Fish & Wildlife Code Section 5.19(K) bars anyone with such an order from engaging in any hunting right, violating this section is a crime. By signing this application, you are subject to a background check.
