- 2. Scholarship Agreement: Please review and sign. Page 2
  - Optional Consent of Release is a document that grants permission to the Higher Education Program to share specific information about an individual with designated third parties. This consent is required to ensure compliance with privacy laws and regulations, such as FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) in the United States, which protects the privacy of student education records. Page 3
- 3. **FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS):** You can access this document on your FAFSA account <u>FAFSA website</u>.
- 4. **Financial Award Information-** Choose 1 of the 3 document submission options below.

Option 1- Financial Award Letter: You may have already received this letter. Try searching your inbox & spam filter for "Financial Award" Or "Financial Aid"

- 8. **Copy of GED, high school, or college transcripts-** First-time applicants who have not applied for the CTUIR scholarship in the past.
- 9. **Personal Letter:** Share your educational goals and future with us.
- 10. **Recommendation Letter:** From someone in your support system.
- 11. **Proof of CTUIR Enrollment:** A copy of your ID card or enrollment certificate.
