Re: Soliciting Recommendations for Board of Trustees 2022-2023 Priorities

The Office of the Executive Director (OED) is preparing draft priorities for the Board of Trustees (BOT) consideration for 2022-2023. The Committees and Commissions provide a valuable means for the membership of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR) to advise the BOT on policy goals and issues. The OED is encouraging that role by inviting each Committee and Commission to identify up to five (5) policy-level issues and/or projects they recommend we consider for adoption as a BOT priority.

The attached document is intended to facilitate consistent documentation of each Committee and Commission's input. The priorities will need to be adopted by a formal recommendation of your respective Committee or Commission.

We will organize the input we receive and share it with the BOT during a work session and at their retreat in March. The BOT's final priorities will be adopted by BOT Resolution and published.
