Key Information to Consider:

Participation in the Land Buy-Back Program is voluntary.

Not all landowners will receive an offer.

The Program's acceptance of returned offers is contingent on the availability of funding.

Allow up to **60 days** after the return-by date for processing and payment of approved offers.

Fair market value will be offered to Indian landowners at the **Umatilla Reservation** for restoring land interests to the Tribe.



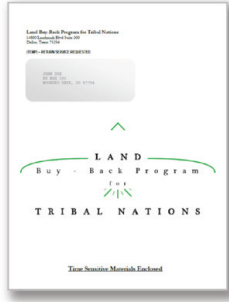
TRIBAL NATIONS

You own fractional land interests at the Umatilla Reservation that are eligible for purchase under the Land Buy-Back Program for Tribal Nations. The Program is offering fair market value for eligible land interests. All interests purchased will be restored to Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR), which helps ensure that Indian lands stays in trust.

If you receive a purchase offer package in the mail from the Buy-Back Program, staff are available to answer questions, assist with Individual Indian Monies (IIM) account updates, explain your options, and help you complete the offer documents.

You may also request appraisal reports for your lands that were appraised as part of Program implementation at the Umatilla Reservation by contacting the Trust Beneficiary Call Center.
