

NOTICE of CTUIR 2023
Bighorn Sheep Limited Entry Hunt

The CTUIR Fish and Wildlife Commission, in recognition of the Treaty reserved right to harvest bighorn sheep and of the highly sensitive political and biological nature of the harvest of these reintroduced populations will use a hunt tag draw system for tribal harvest of these species in Oregon. The draw system will be conducted to optimize hunt opportunities to benefit the greatest number of tribal hunters possible. Applicants must be at least 18 year of age to apply. Permit applications and complete application procedures will be available from Fish and Wildlife Program Staff or on the CTUIR Web site.

Hunt drawing will be conducted in public by the Commission at their regularly scheduled Commission Meeting on July 25 2023. This method and the public setting, will assure that no bias is introduced to the draw program and provide clear accountability to the public.
