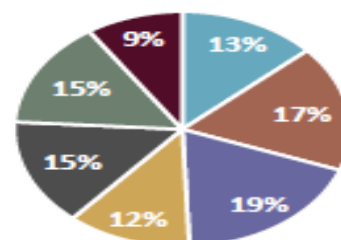

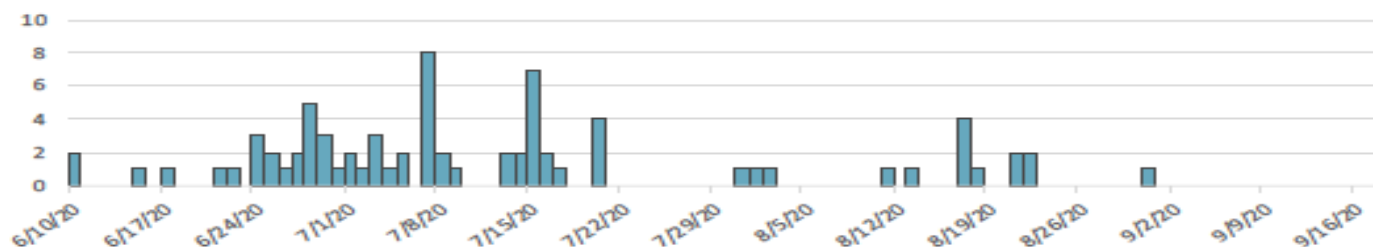

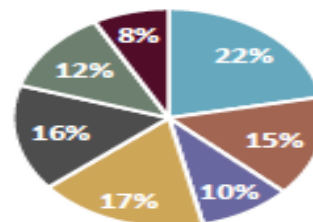

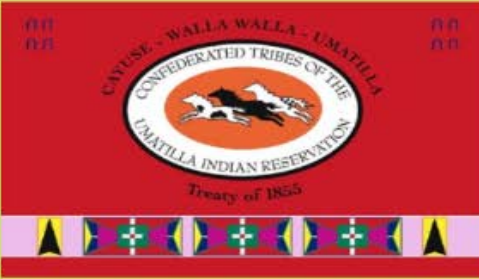

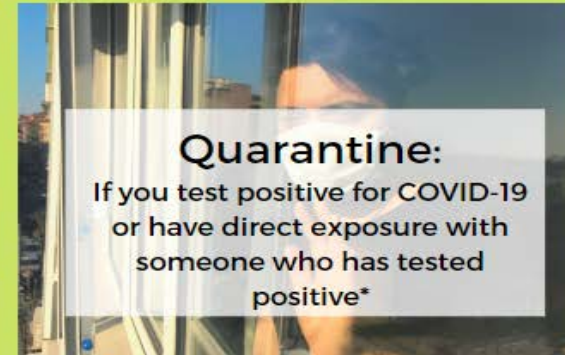
Masks Required:
