HOME OCCUPATION DEFINITION AND REGULATING CRITERIA:

Section 2.020(84) --

A home occupation is any occupation (retail, service, or manufacturing) which is clearly secondary to the main use of the premises as a dwelling place and does not change the character thereof or have any exterior evidence of such secondary use except for a sign advertising such occupation. A home occupation shall comply with the criteria specified in the section 17.005 of this code.

Section 17.005(6) --

The CTUIR will administer home occupations in the following manner:

- 1. A home occupation shall be allowed only within the zones where dwellings are permitted uses.
- 2. A home occupation shall be secondary to the main use of the property as a residence and shall be operated by the resident of the property on which the business is located within the same dwelling or in an accessory building normally associated with uses located in the zone;
- 3. A home occupation shall not exceed 25% of the square footage of the building which it is located in:
- 4. No materials of mechanical equipment shall be used which will be detrimental to the residential use of the property and the adjoining residence because of noise, dust, smoke, odor, or other factors;
- 5. Outside storage of materials, equipment, or products related to the home occupation shall not be allowed;
- 6. The existence of a home occupation shall not be used as justification for any future zone change.
- 7. Individuals requesting a home occupations on the Reservation shall fill out an Home Occupation Administrative Permit (No Fee Required). The permit shall be developed and provided by the Tribal Planning Office containing all the appropriate information necessary for proper records.

If any of the above referenced criteria are not being meet, the home occupation will be considered a violation of the Land Development Code. All violations are subject to the enforcement procedures set forth in the code.
