**Board of Trustees Meeting Recap: May 19, 2025** 

Meeting called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Board of Trustees (BOT) Chairman Gary I. Burke. Invocation given by Member at Large Toby Patrick. Quorum of eight was verified with Member at Large Lisa Ganuelas on personal leave. Agenda approved 7-0-0.

### **New Business**

Rural Transit Day (25-039): The BOT approved a resolution designating July 16 as Rural Transit Day and supporting efforts at the tribal, federal, state, and local levels that promote increases in public funding for rural transit, promote accessibility of public transit for seniors and people with disabilities, promote the availability and connectivity of intercity bus service in rural areas, reduce barriers, and increase job opportunities. The resolution calls for July 16 to be an annual designation, with the first national Rural Transit Day celebrated in 2019 by the Rural Transit Assistance Program, from which the CTUIR's Kayak Public Transit receives assistance. The BOT approved the motion 7-0-0.
