2024 COLUMBIA RIVER WINTER COMMERCIAL GILLNET FISHERY

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Fish and Wildlife Code of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, the Fish and Wildlife Commission has the authority to establish emergency regulations for Umatilla ceremonial, subsistence, and commercial fisheries. Pursuant to that authority, the Fish and Wildlife Commission adopted the following regulations.

ZONE 6 COMMERCIAL SETLINE FISHERY

Area: Bonneville Pool Only

Dates: 6 AM Saturday February 10 to 6 PM Monday February 12, 2024 (2.5 days).

Gear: Setline gear only.

Restrictions: Closed areas in effect include standard dam and river mouth areas applicable to setline

gear.

Allowable Sales: Sturgeon from 38 to 54 inches in fork length in Bonneville Pool may be sold or kept for subsistence purposes. Fish landed during the open periods are allowed to be sold after the period concludes.

Area: John Day and The Dalles Pools

Dates: 6 AM Tuesday February 13 to 6 PM Tuesday February 20, 2024 (6.5 days).

Gear: Setline gear only.

Restrictions: Closed areas in effect include standard dam and river mouth areas applicable to setline gear.

Allowable Sales: Sturgeon from 43 to 54 inches in fork length in The Dalles and John Day Pools may be sold or kept for subsistence purposes. Fish landed during the open periods are allowed to be sold after the period concludes.

24-hour quick reporting required for Washington buyers, pursuant to WAC 220-69-240 except that landings must be reported within 24-hours of completing the fish ticket.
