## **Umatilla Tribal Fire Department Announces Public Comment Period**

The Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR) through the Umatilla Tribal Fire Department (UTFD) applied for the Indian Community Development Block Grant-American Response Plan (ICDBG-APR) grant in 2021 and was placed on the Priority One list through the Office of Native American Programs / Housing and Urban Development (ONAP-HUD). CTUIR-UTFD is requesting an extension on this grant to complete the following items listed below.

The ICDBG-APR grant aims to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The activities planned for the funds were a total of ten projects/equipment that has been completed in 2022; the remainder is listed below:

- 1. Purchase of an Advanced Life Support (ALS) engine to respond to the potential "All Hazards" on and near the Umatilla Indian Reservation (UIR), including COVID-19 patients. It will be replacing an aging first-out engine. Due to multiple factors, inflation and current marketplace price increases in supply chain cost, employee availability & costs, and inventory, the manufacturing completion date is extended to December 2024.
- 2. Purchase a rapid response vehicle with ALS and BLS equipment to respond to "All Hazards," including the COVID patient. The completion date is to July 2023.
