The Summer Youth (SY) Employment Program began July 1st and consisted of about 35 youth. This program gives CTUIR students opportunities to gain work and higher education experiences.





Oregon Tribal Student Grant

DUE: Until funds run out

The Oregon Tribal Student Grant provides assistance to the cost of attendance to eligible Oregon colleges and Universities.

The grant is intended to cover the average cost of attendance after all federal and state grants/scholarships have been applied. Current students and new students are encouraged to apply for this grant for the 2022-2023 academic year.

The Oregon Tribal Student Grant is currently only has funding for the 2022-2023 academic school year. Renewal of the grant for the following years is dependent on funding being available by the Oregon state legislature.

Eligibility:

-Must be enrolled in one of the 9 Oregon federally recognized Tribes.

-Enrolled or accepted into an Oregon University or College. -Complete the Oregon Tribal Student Grant application.

-Submit the FAFSA/ORSAA

-Will be enrolled at least halftime for the academic year of 2022-2023.

-Maintain good academic standing

-Working towards earning first degree or credential.

Gates Scholarship OPEN for 2023-2024

The Gates Scholarship is a competitive scholarship for Pell-eligible, minority, high school seniors.

The full cost of attendance will be covered by this scholarship. However, the award may vary depending on other financial aid and FAFSA

Students must plan to enroll fulltime, in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university. Eligibility:

- A high school senior
- From at least one of the following ethnicities: African-American, American Indian/Alaska Native*, Asian & Pacific Islander American, and/or Hispanic American
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)




The Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's Community College Internship (CCI)
